

Company Onstage COVID-19 Guidelines

The Company OnStage is overjoyed to be able to welcome back our patrons and volunteers to the magic of live theatre. In keeping with our dedication to the health and well-being of all who enter our theatre, we are issuing the following safety protocols:

- Patrons are asked to conduct a self-assessment prior to coming to the theatre. If you or anyone in your party is experiencing symptoms of headache, cough, fever, difficulty breathing, sore throat, loss of sense of smell/taste, or a general feeling of sickness, we respectfully ask that you do not come to the theatre. You may contact us and we will be happy to re-schedule your attendance for another time.
- Pre-purchased tickets through the website are recommended.
- Box office will open 30 minutes prior to curtain, please arrive early. Any tickets not claimed will be released 5 minutes prior to curtain.
- Seats will be assigned allowing for proper distancing between groups.
- If a performance is sold out, walk-in attendees will be allowed once all reserved tickets are picked up or released. If there is a waiting list, walk-in attendees will be asked to leave name and cell number with box office and wait in car or appropriately distanced location and will be notified via text if we can accommodate or not.
- For the safety of everyone in attendance, all patrons and volunteers are asked to wear masks while inside the building. Masks are available in the lobby.
- Hand sanitizer will be readily available for public use.
- Social distancing is encouraged.
- Visiting with actors/crew post-performance, will take place outside in the breezeway or courtyard. No large groups may gather in the lobby.

Please note, The Company Onstage asked all eligible performers, directors, and technical crew to be fully vaccinated prior to the beginning of rehearsals. Protocols will be implemented backstage and in the dressing room for their well-being as well as the well-being of our patrons.

While The Company OnStage is implementing measures to help reduce the spread of COVID-19, we cannot guarantee that you and/or your guests will not be exposed or become infected with COVID-19.
